The motion to adjourn was initiated by Trustee Umans and seconded by Member Skalla at 11:34am. Unanimously carried.

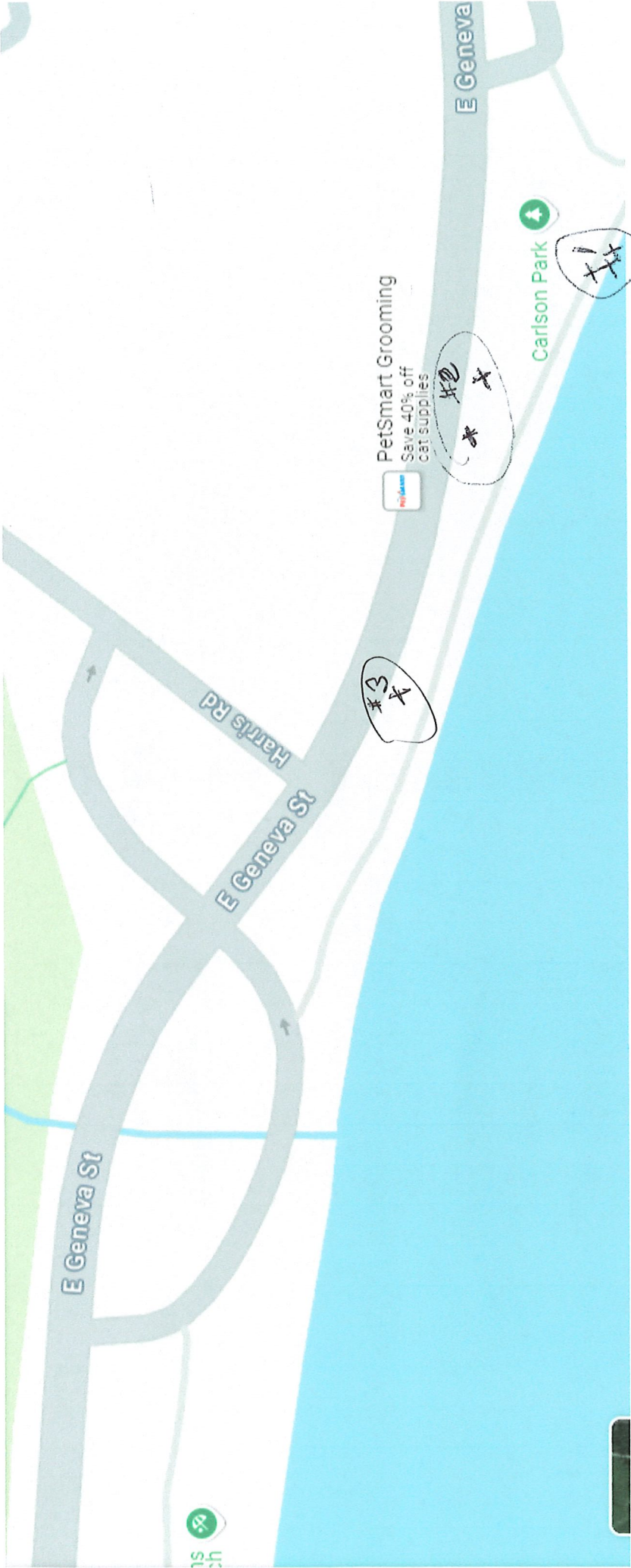

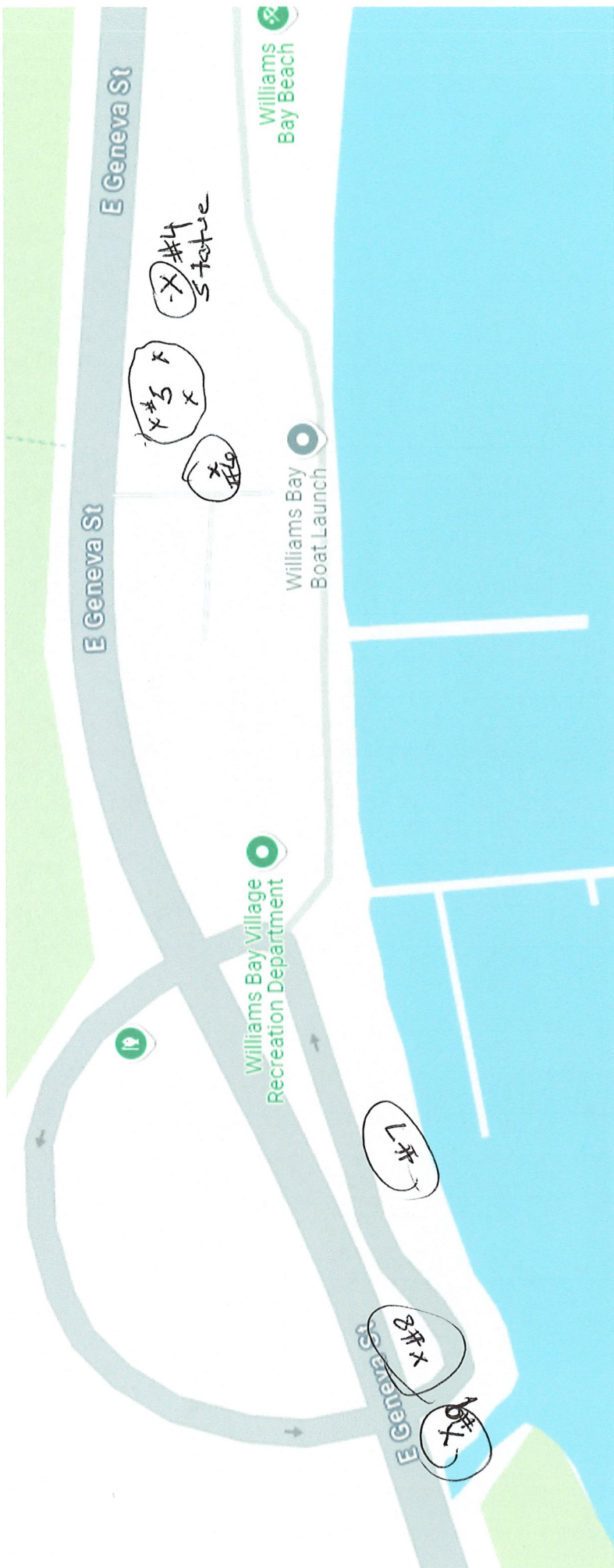
