Gluth stated that she'd like to see a short biography of Bob Carlson put on the website so that people who visit the park can look up why it is named after him.

The Committee discussed having a sign be put up matching the other Village park signs, but having it say "Bob Carlson Memorial Park" after discussing that with Bob's family.

Gluth/Fieweger motion to recommend Village Board approval of naming the park east of the beach after Bob Carlson with a sign after discussing the title with Bob's family and to post a short biography on the Village website about Bob Carlson and his dedication to serving the Village.
