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OFFICIAL MINUTES PROTECTIVE SERVICES COMMITTEE 12/20/21 MEETING MONDAY, DECEMBER 20, 2021 AT 6:30 PM VILLAGE HALL COUNCIL ROOM

I. Call to Order

Vlach called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

II. Roll Call

Present: George Vlach, Jim D'Alessandro, Robert Umans

Also Present: President Duncan, Trustee Parker and Wright, Administrator Tobin, Treasurer Peternell, Police Chief Timm, Fire Chief Smith, Assistant Chief Nicholson, Lieutenant Balsitis, Rescue Captain Gluth and McKean.

III. EMS Discussion

Vlach recapped the discussions that have been occurring with the Town of Delavan and Fontana regarding EMS staffing options. Vlach stated that Metro Medical Service is having difficulties hiring the 6 paramedics that were included in their referendum. He stated that if the Village were to contract with Town of Delavan it would require the Village to decertify their department and EMS service would be completely provided by Metro. If the Village were to partner with Fontana there would be an opportunity to share staff and share certifications. Estimated costs for the Village would be approximately \$550,000 to partner with Fontana for 6 members. Tobin suggested hiring 1 AEMT and Fontana would get the billings for Williams Bay for 2022 and then go to referendum for funding for 6 members and negotiating with Fontana at that time. Fontana is requesting the Village continue discussions on what the long term plan will be.

IV. Adjourn

The motion to adjourn was initiated by George Vlach and seconded by Robert Umans at 7:21pm. Unanimously carried.
